Midterm Exam Information

Midterm exams will be held January 25th through the 28th at Ernest Manning Centre. All students are required to write the exams. There will be 2 sessions per morning, 9:00 – 10:30 am and 11:00 – 12:30 pm. Students may write the exams in the order of their preference and may choose to write 2 exams in one morning. Instructions on how to sign up for space in the exam room will be posted to the Junior High Homeroom course early in January.

- Special supplies such as graph paper, exam booklets, etc. are provided, but students are expected to bring pens, pencils, calculator, etc. as required for their courses.
- Students must arrive at the beginning of the test session to minimize disruptions.
- Students will not be admitted to the testing room 15 minutes after the test has started.
- Water bottles are permitted, but food / pop cans are not allowed.

Term 2 Report Cards

Term 2 report cards will be mailed on March 15th. The next round of Parent/Teacher Interviews has been scheduled for Monday, March 22nd. Times and location will be posted in the Junior High Homeroom schedule (calendar) closer to the date.

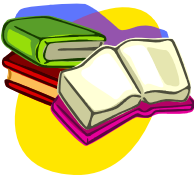
