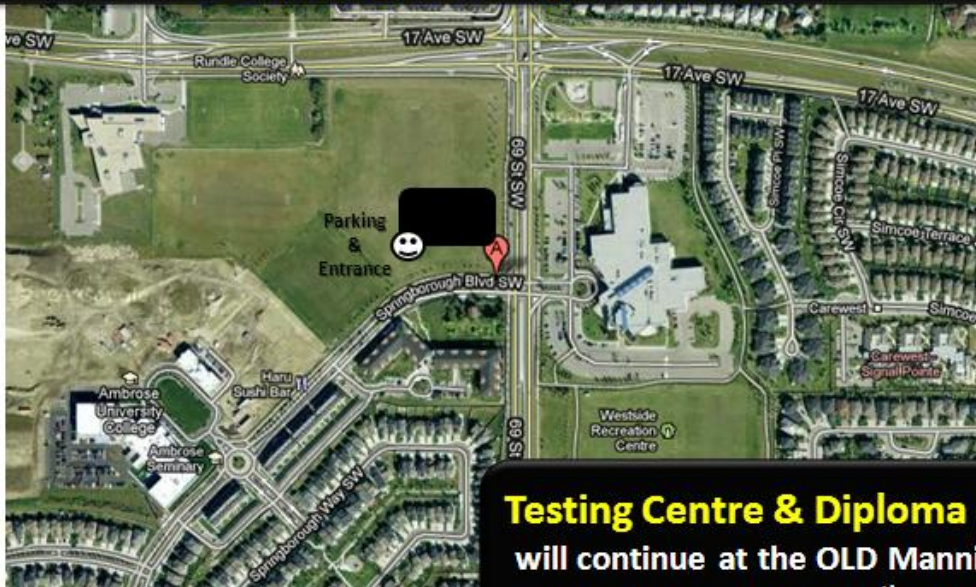


Transitioning from Grade 9 to Grade 10

CBe-learn offers a full online program for students in grades 7 through 12. At the end of ninth grade, CBe-learn students are automatically enrolled in our high school program. Students who plan to attend an alternate high school must visit the school of their choice or designation to request an official transfer to that school. The new school will initiate the transfer process and complete your enrolment according to their guidelines. Students who plan to attend CBe-learn in grade 10 will need to register for term 1 in August. Our Guidance team can provide program planning support by appointment, and our registration team will be happy to serve you at our new location.

Selecting Grade 10 Courses

Alberta Education has created a [Senior High Curriculum Handbook for Parents](http://education.alberta.ca/media/445715/srpub.pdf) (link: <http://education.alberta.ca/media/445715/srpub.pdf>). This document outlines the requirements, choices and processes involved in planning your child's high school program, and will help you to provide assistance and advice to your child. An important part of the transition from grade 9 to grade 10 is to have future goals in mind when planning for and enrolling in grade 10 programs. Some grade 10 courses are prerequisites for more advanced high school courses. As well, certain programs enable students to meet entry requirements for post-secondary programs or to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary to enter directly into a career after high school. Letters were mailed in April that indicated teacher recommendations for enrolment in each subject area. If you have any questions or concerns about teacher recommendations for a specific subject area, it is best to direct these to the corresponding teacher.
